


Q6 What is your level of satisfaction with public safety services in Chaves County?







Q9 If your answer to Question #8 was yes, what type of employment are you engaged in?









Q10 If you are unemployed, what is the main reason that has prevented you from getting a job?








Q16 What is your level of satisfaction with commercial retail and services in Chaves County?

Q17 Where do you go for shopping and commercial services? (Choose all that apply).






Q18 Should renewable energy, such as wind, solar, and biofuels, be expanded in Chaves County?






Q21 What is your level of satisfaction with Chaves County's current roadway conditions and maintenance?





Q24 What, if any, are the biggest issues facing Chaves County's water supply? (Choose all that apply).







Q25 Do you rent or own your home?



Q26 What housing development types does Chaves County need more of? (Choose all that apply)



Q27 What housing building types does Chaves County need more of? (Choose all that apply)



Q28 What is your gender?



Q29 What is your age category?




Q30 What is the highest level of education you have attained?
